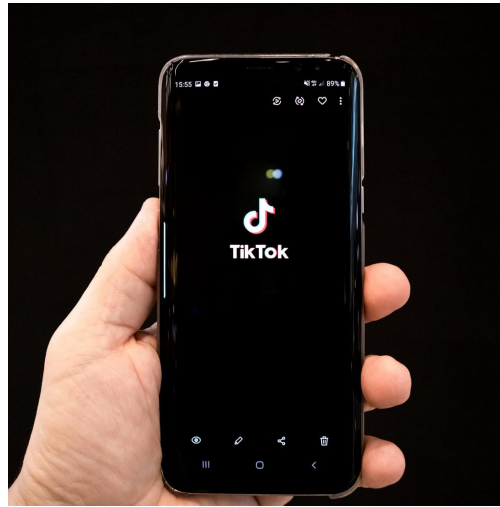
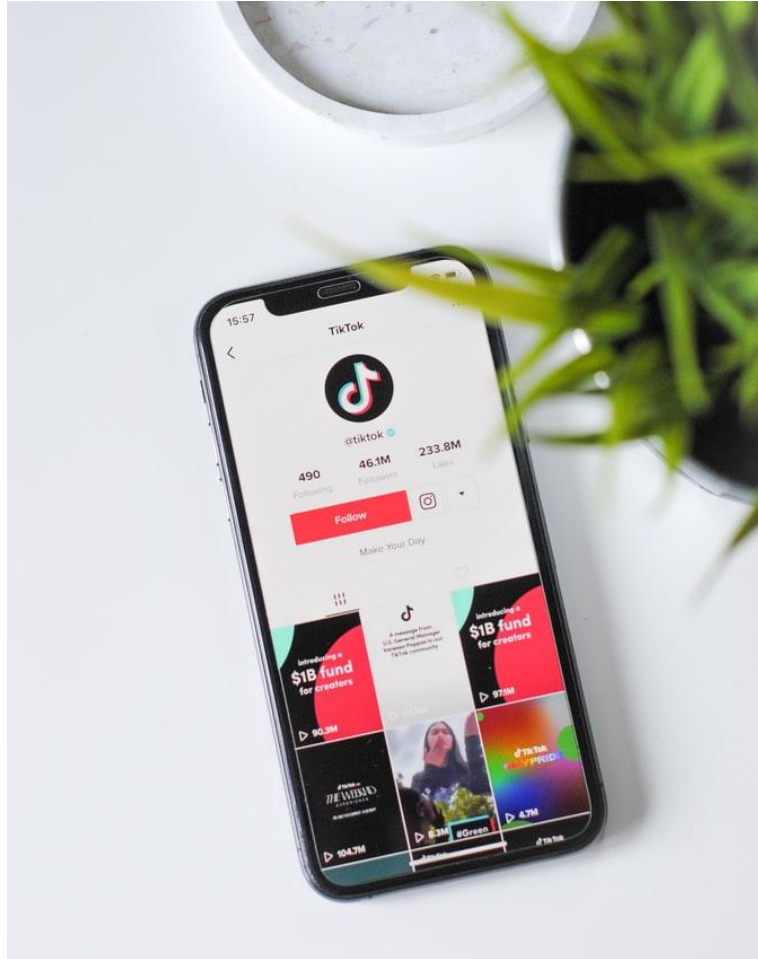


TikTok as an Educational Resource
